4C FRAMEWORK™- PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

INTEGRATION REQUIRES

- Understanding of the treatment program
 - What the 4C Sessions are integrating upon
- Overlap
 - 4C Sessions begin while client is still in the safe, controlled environment of the treatment center
- Hand-off process
 - Create a continuum of care
 - Warm intro from trusted individuals
- Clear, consistent, communication processes and touchpoints
- Teamwork mentality
 - 4C Sessions are part of the greater whole
 - Building a shared approach and shared language
- Community resource conversations

PARTICIPATION REQUIRES

- Warm hand-off to Continuing Care, the 4C Framework, and the facilitator(s)
- · Means to join virtual sessions (ex. computer, tablet, cell phone) consistently and on time
- Means to access printed materials (ex. printing client packages when workbooks are not purchased)
- Dedicated time, and has access to a comfortable, private space for each session
- Meets participation expectations (ex. engages with the 4C Framework materials)
- Sequential sessions
- Policies: understanding and adherence to cancellation, no-show, and completion policies
- Communication is clear and proactive



4C FRAMEWORK™- ONBOARDING PACKAGE

ESSENTIAL ONBOARDING

\$600*

- Team introduction & Onboarding
 - Familiarizing the team with our program and laying the groundwork for successful collaboration. Build trust and shared language, and develop a hand-off process for continuum of care.
- Program Conversations
 - Ensure mutual understanding of programming approaches, processes, workflows, resources etc.
- Community Resource Clarification
 - Establish an outline of practical continuing care resources in community.
- Workflow Development
 - Partnership in developing administration and operations workflow, including scheduling to optimize client experience, communications workflows, etc.
- Integration Interviews
 - With key stakeholders for inclusivity and cultural sensitivity and resource development

IT SYSTEMS ONBOARDING FOR CLIENTS

 Individual session to support client's tech literacy with an introduction to the IT systems used to schedule and join sessions 1 hour

• Setup and practice access to email, calendar, booking tools, and completing surveys

COMMUNITY RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT LIASON

- Conduct integration interviews with key stakeholders
- Develop rapport & collaboration on practical continuing care resources in community

BOOSTER ONGOING SUPPORT

\$250*/month

 Extension of our virtual Alumni Support Group - additional group meeting structure and worksheets that support building on tools and resources from the core program 1 hour/month

STRUCTURE

- After completion of the core program, in combination with the Alumni Support Group, the additional booster session creates two group sessions per month
- Supports continuing engagement with the 4C Framework materials
- Many studies show booster sessions increase the likelihood of program adherence
- Participants benefit from group sessions where they practice vulnerability in community safe space, learn from their peers which increases relevance and applicability, and experience group accountability
- Encourages further engagement with and builds community

WORKBOOK

\$45*/book

- Comprehensive workbook includes all worksheets and exercises for the core program, as well as ongoing exercises and prompts for continuing engagement with the framework
- The workbook encourages integration and empowerment by placing the tools directly in the individual's hands where they can build reliance on their own individualized system
